ACOM 1200S Air Filter Information

A customer recently (24 April 2019) sent in information concerning the air filter in the ACOM 1200S Amplifier and we wanted to pass this on to other Acom 1200S users:

"It may interest you, that during annual shack cleaning and equipment maintenance, I attempted removal of the 1200S air filters for cleaning as detailed on page 27 of the 1200S manual.

My interpretation of instructions for accessing the power supply air filter (#2) requires removing two screws on the bottom of the amplifier, which retain the filter tray; after performing this task, the filter could not be removed.

Upon removal of the amplifier cover, two additional screws were discovered that also must be removed to release the filter tray.

You may wish to update the amplifier documentation to clarify amplifier cover removal, for access to the additional filter tray retention screws?

Having used the 1200 for a year, I remain pleased with its performance and features, thanks to all at Acom for producing this excellent amplifier."

ACOM sent the answer:

"Thank you very much for your suggestion. The Operating Manual was written when only few prototypes were produced.

Obviously the additional screws were added later with the serial production. I will discuss with the designers if something could be changed there. If it turns out to be impossible, the Manual will be updated."
